Sufficient to Meet Licensure or Certification Requirements:

Nutrition/Dietetics Technician Registered

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Nutrition & Dietetics offered by Samford University along with program requirements of the Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD), if successfully completed, has been identified as sufficient to meet certification requirements including the Standards of Education of Nutrition/Dietetics Technician Registered. Upon successful completion of BS degree in Nutrition and Dietetics and DPD program requirements, students will receive a Verification Statement indicating eligibility to take the national credentialing exam to become a Nutrition/Dietetics Technician Registered (NDTR or DTR). The Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD) in the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics at Samford University is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND), the accrediting agency of the Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics.

Registered Dietitian Nutritionist

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Nutrition & Dietetics offered by Samford University along with program requirements of the Didactic Program in Dietetics (DPD), if successfully completed, has been identified as sufficient to meet requirements for entry into a Dietetic Internship Program. Upon successful completion of BS degree in Nutrition and Dietetics and DPD program requirements, students will receive a DPD Verification Statement. The signed verification statement documents that an individual has completed the requirements of a nutrition and dietetics education program accredited by the Accreditation Council for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics (ACEND) and allows an individual to establish eligibility for a Dietetic Internship program. Upon successful completion of a Dietetic Internship and master's degree, an individual may take the national credentialing exam to become a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist.
